





Men's IHF World Championship 2025 Media accreditations Terms and conditions

INTRODUCTION

The International Handball Federation (IHF), the men's 2025 Organising Committees (OC) and Sportfive, the federation's exclusive media and marketing partner, recognise the importance of top quality media coverage of the men's IHF world championship 2025 which will take place in Croatia, Denmark and Norway from January 14 to February 2, 2025, and strive to offer the highest standard of media services for accredited media representatives. These terms and conditions (T&Cs) set out the conditions under which the IHF, Sportfive and OCs provide a successful applicant with an accreditation and access to the IHF world championship venues.

APPLYING FOR AN ACCREDITATION

Applications will only be accepted via the dedicated online accreditation system within the specified time period. Email accreditation requests will not be accepted. Requests submitted after the published deadline will not be processed.

By submitting a request for an accreditation, the applicant confirms that this is made with the full knowledge and consent of his/her employer and that he/she is authorised to enter into this legally binding agreement for him/herself and his/her employer. Applicants must be aged 18 or over to receive a media accreditation.

APPLYING FOR AN ACCREDITATION (WRITTEN MEDIA/PHOTOGRAPHERS)

A media accreditation is only open to professional media representatives working at the Event for a recognised media outlet. Media representatives, and in particular freelancers, may also be asked to provide additional evidence of their work and previous coverage of handball events.

APPLYING FOR AN ACCREDITATION (TV AND RADIO)

Sportfive is responsible for all accreditation requests from TV and radio representatives. Before making an accreditation request, an agreement concerning the relevant media rights must be reached with Sportfive well in advance of the deadline for media accreditation applications. Non-rights holders applications will be handled jointly by IHF and Sportfive.

CONFIRMATION/DENIAL OF ACCREDITATION REQUEST

All applicants will be informed by email whether their application has been successful. Acceptance of an accreditation request is entirely at the discretion of the IHF, Sportive and the OCs. The IHF and/or Sportfive may accept or reject accreditation requests entirely at their own discretion and can impose further terms and conditions. Given that there are









limited media places available, it may not be possible to accept all requests for a media accreditation.

COLLECTION OF ACCREDITATIONS

Accreditations may only be picked up by the bearer and not by a representative unless agreed otherwise. Accreditations will only be issued on receipt of a valid photographic identification (e.g. passport, driver's licence) together with a copy of the confirmation email. Accreditations can only be picked up from the accreditation centre at the arrival venue indicated in the course of the application process or as informed to the organisers prior to the Event.

USE OF ACCREDITATION

Media representatives must wear their accreditation visible at all times in the playing arena on both match and non-match days, as well as training sessions. Accreditations are only valid together with a valid photographic identification (e.g. passport or driving licence), which the media representative may be required to provide at any time.

Accredited media representatives are only allowed in the designated zones as displayed on their accreditation and must follow the signposted routing within the playing arena. Accreditations are non-transferrable and may only be used by the bearer and may not be assigned to any other person. In case the bearer loses the accreditation, he/she must contact the organisers or Sportfive immediately.

Each application for a reprint will be handled separately. Lost accreditations will be cancelled in order to prevent and avoid misuse.

CONDUCT AND WITHDRAWAL OF ACCREDITATIONS

Media representatives who do not comply with the T&Cs or any other guideline issues by IHF or Sportfive before or during the Event will have their accreditation withdrawn and may be restricted from attending future IHF events as a media representative.

The IHF and/or Sportfive may ask an accredited media representative to share proof of their work at any time before, during or after the Event. In this case the evidence must be provided within 24 hours of the request. Should this evidence not be provided, the IHF and/or Sportfive may withdraw the accreditation.

Accredited media representatives must behave in an orderly manner throughout the Event. Any abusive behaviour or unbecoming conduct will result in expulsion from all venues.

Once an accreditation is granted, it may be revoked at any time without liability for compensation to the applicant. The accreditation of any person found to be accredited under false pretences will be invalidated immediately.

DATA RELATED MATTERS

As an accredited media representative your accreditation data will be retained by the IHF, Sportifve and accreditation partner HSM. This data will be treated in the strictest confidence and will only be shared with our partners and the OC of the host nation(s) for the purposes of event organisation. We also reserve the right to share your data,









according to the laws and regulations of the host nation(s), with law enforcement authorities in order to carry out any necessary security checks.

DATA NECESSARY FOR THE ACCREDITATION PROCESS

In the registration process, we collect the following (personal) data from you. Data marked with an asterisk (*) are mandatory:

DATA USE

We will only process personal data that you provide to us voluntarily and for the purposes for which you have given us the data. Otherwise, we will process your personal data to the extent it is necessary in particular for the performing of a contract to which you are party, or for the compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject, and always in accordance with the Croatian, Danish and Norwegian Data Protection law and the General Data Protection Regulation (short "**GDPR**").1 Your data will not be transferred to third parties without your express consent and treated with utmost confidentiality. For the avoidance of doubts, HSM, Sportfive and the OC shall not be considered as third parties for the purposes of these T&Cs.

We will process the personal data provided by you in the registration process for the following purposes:

- Use for the accreditation process of the Event;
- Answering requests you made to us, including in a feedback form, by email or telephone

 Sending you emails with essential Event information including news, media announcements and releases.









• Sending you a follow-up by email after the Event.

You may revoke your consent at any time and without providing reasons, with effect for the future. If you revoke your consent to processing of data necessary for the accreditation process as indicated in the present T&Cs, kindly note that we cannot process your accreditation request. In order to revoke your consent, please send us an email to <u>ank@danskhaandbold.dk</u>. We may have to ask you for appropriate identification, depending on the type of data we have stored from you or not.

If you revoke your consent, we will delete any personal data for which we have no legal storage obligation and will restrict the processing of the stored data to the said purpose in the future. The IHF, Sportfive and the OC will **delete** any personal data at the latest two (2) years after the last day of the year in which the Event took place, unless there is a legal obligation of the IHF, Sportfive or OCs to process and / or store data for a longer period (e.g. invoices).

Furthermore, we wish to make you aware that you have further specific rights granted to you under the GDPR and the Croatian, Danish and Norwegian Data Protection laws, in particular, but not limited to the rights to information which personal data and for which purposes they are stored and processed, to rectification of inaccurate personal data, a right to object and / or of restriction of the further processing of such data, and of data portability.
